Hurricane/Tropical Storm Debby Preparations for Business

As Debby approaches Oak Island, it is crucial for local businesses to take proactive measures to safeguard their property, assets, and employees. With severe flooding expected, preparation in the days leading up to the storm can make a substantial difference. By following these essential tips, businesses can minimize damage and ensure a swift recovery once the storm passes.

Property Protection

- 1. Check Drainage Systems: Ensure gutters, downspouts, and drainage systems are clear of debris to prevent water buildup and flooding.
- 2. **Inspect the Building**: Seal any cracks or openings in the windows, doors, and walls to prevent water from entering the building.
